

STUDENT IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

ONE PIECE ONLY OF PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION REQUIRED

OR – If the candidate does not possess valid Photo I.D.

ACCEPTABLE PHOTOGRAPHIC IDENTIFICATION

- Valid Canadian or U.S. driver's license
- Valid passport
- Valid B.C. Student Identification Card Issued for the current school year
- Employee picture identification card
- Native status picture identification card
- BC Photo Identification (digital) issued 11/96 or after

ONE PIECE OF PRIMARY I.D.

PLUS

TWO PIECES OF SECONDARY I.D.

PRIMARY IDENTIFICATION

- Birth certificate
- Canadian citizenship I.D.
- Canadian Record of Landing
- Canadian Student Visa
- Canadian Work Visa
- Returning Resident Permit

SECONDARY IDENTIFICATION

- Naturalization Certificate
- Marriage Certificate
- Change of Name Cert.
- Parole Certificate
- Correctional Service Conditional Release Card
- Valid credit card (if name on card)
- Bank card (if name on card)
- Occupational First Aid Level 1, 2, or 3 certificate
- Occupational First Aid TE certificate
- Vehicle Registration
- Firearms Acquisition Cert
- Social Insurance (if offered)
- BC Care Card (if offered)

OR – If candidate does not possess any of the above identification:

A letter from their employer on company letterhead, signed by an official of the company, stating the employee is who they claim to be. This must be GIVEN to the instructor on the day of the class.

OR -

A letter from a sponsoring governmental or other agency, on agency letterhead, signed by an official of the agency, stating that the candidate is who they claim to be. This must be GIVEN to the instructor on the day of the class.
